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### II. Approval of Minutes – May 6, 2025, Airport Commission Meeting

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### IV. Reports

#### A. Airport Director's Report

Ms. Hupp presented the Director's Report. There were no comments.

#### B. Commissioner Comments

They praised her as an exceptional leader and expressed their full confidence in the team she leaves behind to continue BOI's success.

### **C. Airport Staff Report – FAA instrument Flight Procedure Overview presented via zoom by Joe Bert and Jennifer Redding.**

Mr. Bert and Ms. Redding presented an overview of the FAA's instrument flight procedures to the Commission. The Commission, Mr. Bert, and Ms. Redding discussed the procedure for submitting requests, the appeals process, the rules governing aircraft turns and banking, the timeline for responding to inquiries, and the FOIA filing process.

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### **V. Public Comment – Questions & Answers**

Deborah Ferguson of Ferguson Durham informed the Commission that the FAA had responded to the FOIA request. She asked the Commission to access the portal and review the wildlife corridor information.

Kendra Kenyon addressed the Commission regarding proposed new flight pathways and aviation safety concerns. She discussed the potential impacts on eagles, hawks, and turkey vultures, emphasizing the need for further evaluation. She also referenced the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and recommended that bird nesting areas be considered as part of aviation safety planning.
